Technical Proposal: Section B - Experience	Tenderers are required to fill in the experience table in Annex III and provide information showing the aggregate experience of the key project team member (the one with the most relevant experience) or the Tenderer's aggregate experience in operating smart recycling bins or managing big data platforms. Does it imply that tenders are required to choose key project team member or the Tenderer when filling in the experience table?	To fill in Section B – Experiences under Annex III, Tenderers can choose to provide either: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The aggregate experience of the most experienced key project team member, in which case the projects where that specific team member was involved should be listed, OR 2. The Tenderer's aggregate experience, in which case the projects undertaken by the Tenderer (i.e. the organization/company) should be listed.
Nature of Procurement	Are Contractors providing food waste smart bins (FWSBs) to the ECC through a rental arrangement or as a supply of goods ? Given that the contract only involves 12-month warranty period and a 12-month maintenance period (i.e. a total of 24-month operation period), what follow-up arrangements will be available after the maintenance period expires if the private housing estates wish to continue using the FWSBs?	<p>This is a tender for the supply of goods. Contractors are required to supply and deliver FWSBs and food waste buckets to the Designated Locations as requested by the ECC Representative. According to Clause 11.1 of Condition of Contract, once an Acceptance Note is issued, all title, beneficial ownership, and interest in the Goods shall become and remain the exclusive property of the ECC, free from all liens, claims, mortgages, charges, encumbrances, contractual rights, and third party rights or interests of any nature.</p> <p>The scope of the contract does not include any follow-up arrangements beyond the maintenance period, as these fall outside the contract's duration. For continued use of the FWSBs after this period, Contractors may directly engage with the private housing estates regarding operation and associated costs.</p>
